

Notice of Public Hearing

A public hearing shall be held by the Board of County Commissioners of Trumbull County on Thursday, March 15, 2018 at 7 PM at the Brookfield Township Administration Building, located at 6844 Strimbu Drive, Brookfield, Ohio 44403, when and where objections to or endorsement of Project No. 12-S-07, South Bedford Road Sanitary Sewer Improvements, Metropolitan Sanitary Sewer District, referred to in a Resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on February 14, 2018 and described therein will be heard by the Board.

The project consists of construction of gravity sewers together with all necessary appurtenances thereto and the location route and termini of the Project is described generally as beginning at an existing manhole approximately 100 feet east of the intersection of Bedford Road and Stewart Sharon Road and extend west along the north side of Stewart Sharon Road approximately 1,260 linear feet to termination at a proposed manhole; Furthermore, the sewer will extend from a proposed manhole at the intersection of Bedford Road and Stewart Sharon Road to the southeast along the east side of Bedford Road approximately 400 linear feet to termination at a proposed manhole; Furthermore, the sewer will extend from an existing manhole near the West Elm Street and Bedford Road intersection extending northwesterly along the east side of Bedford Road approximately 1,757 linear feet to termination at a proposed manhole; Furthermore, beginning at an existing manhole on the west side of Bedford Road approximately 550 feet southeast of the West Elm Street intersection extending northwesterly along the west side of Bedford Road approximately 420 linear feet to a proposed manhole. The project will also include 6" service connections (including risers where necessary) within the public right-of-way and 17 pre-cast concrete manholes

The resolution provides that portion of the cost not covered by grant funds will be recovered in the form of monthly capital charges to be billed to the owners of benefited properties within the Metropolitan Sanitary Sewer District, which are described as all those properties to be serviced with sanitary sewer as a result of the project, now and in the future.

The detailed plans, specifications and estimates of cost for the project are now on file in the office of the County Sanitary Engineer, 842 Youngstown Kingsville Road, Vienna, Ohio, and open to the inspection of all interested parties.

Written objections to, or endorsement of the Project, or to the cost, scope and boundaries thereof will be received by the Board of County Commissioners for a period of five (5) business days after the hearing, and no action will be taken by the Board in the matter until after such period has elapsed.
