Due to rising COVID-19 cases in the State of Ohio and Trumbull County, as well as recommendations made by Governor Dewine, the White House, CDC and local Public Health Officials, the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners is issuing a public notice of temporary changes to public access to County Government services, located within the Administration Building. These temporary changes are being made in an attempt to address the current COVID-19 public health crisis wherein an aggressive response is necessary to control the spread of the virus. Closures and limitations in public access to County services are based on what are considered essential services. The health and safety of the public and our employees is of our utmost concern as well as the rights of all individuals.

In an effort to comply with directives from Governor Dewine and the Ohio Department of Health to limit gatherings and limit physical contacts in effort to control the spread of COVID-19, the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners determined that it is necessary to make operational adjustments within the Trumbull County Administration building located at 160 High Street effective November 19, 2020 until otherwise notified.
