To All Interested Agencies, Groups, and Individuals:

On or about, but not before, December 1, 2021, the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners will submit a request to the State of Ohio for the release of Federal funds under Section 104 (g) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; Section 288 of Title II of the Cranston Gonzales National Affordable Housing Act (NAHA), as amended; and/or Title IV of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act, as amended; to be used for the following project(s):

1/1 West Farmington Sanitary Lateral Household Connections and Professional Services; CDBG funds dedicated is \$322,400; the funds are to be used for professional consulting services and construction of sanitary lateral connections for approximately 38 income-eligible households, the final number of beneficiaries is contingent on bid results and available funds; Single-Year Project; West Farmington Village, Trumbull County, Ohio; Estimated Cost of Project is \$322,400

2/2 Girard Multi-Generational Center Roof Replacement; CDBG funds dedicated is \$132,800; RLF funds dedicated is \$10,000; the funds are to be used for the replacement of a roof at 443 Trumbull Avenue, Girard, OH 44420; Single-Year Project; City of Girard, Trumbull County, Ohio; Estimated Cost of Project is \$142,800; an additional \$7,200 is being used for professional services (2/1) and is an exempt activity

The activities proposed are categorically excluded under U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations at 24 CFR Part 58 from National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements. ### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to Mauro Cantalamessa, President, Board of Trumbull County Commissioners, Trumbull County Administration Building, 160 High Street NW, 5th Floor, Warren, Ohio 44481 by U.S. mail or email at the addresses above. All comments received before December 1, 2021 will be considered by the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners' prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION**

The Board of Trumbull County Commissioners, certifies to the State of Ohio that Mauro Cantalamessa in his capacity as President of the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the

environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The State of Ohio's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners to use Program funds.

### **OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS**

The State of Ohio will accept objections to its release of funds and the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners ; (b) the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the State of Ohio; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development at [OCD@development.ohio.gov](mailto:OCD@development.ohio.gov). Potential objectors should contact the State of Ohio to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
