The American Rescue Plan (ARP) amended Title VI of the Social Security Act 17 (the Act) to add section 602, which establishes the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, and section 603, which establishes the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund. Section 603(c)1 provides that funds may be used to make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure. ARP encourages the use of Fiscal Recovery Funds in accordance with the priorities of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) or Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) to assist systems most in need on a per household basis according to state affordability criteria. According to the Final Rule funds can be used to make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure including for building or upgrading facilities and transmission, distribution, and storage systems, replacement of lead service lines, green infrastructure improvements, implementing cybersecurity practices and measures and addressing climate change (example: pollution prevention measures taken reducing the energy required to treat drinking water).
